Set a positive example for both our community and your player by demonstrating good sportsmanship and respectful behavior.
- **Respect Officials:** Officials at local youth basketball tournaments are often volunteers and face the challenge of calling the rules in a subjective manner for players with a wide range of experience and ability. Please show respect by refraining from questioning their decisions during or after the games. Officials play a crucial role in ensuring the tournaments are even possible for all participants.
- **Remain a Spectator:** Do not yell instructions to your player or other players during games. This may contradict the offensive or defensive plan of the coach.
- **Addressing Concerns:** If you have concerns regarding the team, coaching, or your player's experience, please address these concerns through the appropriate channels (coach or association leadership) in a calm and constructive manner.
- **Encourage Independence:** Encourage your player to speak directly with the coach when they have concerns or questions, helping them build communication and problem-solving skills.
- **Volunteer and Assist:** The RCW Basketball Association organizes the 4th-6th grade girls' and boys' basketball programs, along with other youth camps. We pay the cost of all tournament entry fees for all teams so that expense doesn't fall to the parents. Please volunteer to support the team or association, whether by helping to organize team events or assisting with fundraising efforts. Your involvement is imperative to keep player registration fees low.

When is sick too sick for school?

A regular attendance routine is important for your child's well-being and learning. These tips can help you decide when to keep your child home when they don't feel well.



SEND ME TO SCHOOL IF...

- I have a **runny nose** or just a **little cough**, but no other symptoms.
- I have **NOT** had a **fever overnight** and **have NOT** taken **fever reducing medicine** during that time.
- I have a **mild stomach ache**.
- I have **not thrown up** overnight and can drink liquids without throwing up.
- I have a **mild rash** and no other symptoms.
- I have **eye drainage WITHOUT** fever, eye pain or eyelid redness.



KEEP ME AT HOME IF...

- I have a **temperature higher than 100.4**
- I have **thrown up two or more times** in the past 24 hours.
- My **stool is watery** and I may not make it to the bathroom in time.



SEEK MEDICAL CARE IF...

- I have a **temperature higher than 100.4 AND any of the following**: ear pain, sore throat, rash, stomachache, headache or tooth pain.
- I have **stomach pain and fever**, I have **bloody or black stool**, or I am **dehydrated** (tired and sleepy, dry mouth) and/or I have **not urinated** in the last 8 hours.
- I have a **persistent cough** or **trouble breathing**, or have a fever with the cough.
- I have **eye swelling, eye pain** or an **eye injury**.
- I have a **rash that has blisters**, is draining, is painful, looks like bruises, and/or I have a fever with the rash.

If you don't know whether to send your child to school, have specific concerns regarding your child's physical or mental health,
