What You Can Receive: Certificate of Class Completion, CA Dental Practice Act Certificate, 8-Hour Infection Control Certificate, Radiation Safety Certificate, Coronal Polishing Certificate, and Basic Life Support (BLS) Certificate. (contingent on 95% attendance & grade of C or better)

Course Cost: \$3,350 (includes a non-refundable \$70 registration fee). Full payment or partial payment of \$1,700 is required at registration, and \$1,675 (includes a \$25 installation fee) is due at the half way point of the class 03/25/27.

Patient Requirement: Student must provide 4 patients for dental Xray and 3 patients for coronal polishing practice.

FOUNDATIONS IN DENTAL ASSISTING

This class prepares students with the necessary manipulative skills, technical knowledge, and hands-on experience to obtain entry-level dental assisting employment. All students receive their x-ray license upon successful completion of the Dental Assisting Program. This course meets the mandatory 8 hour Infection Control and California Dental Practice Act and Coronal Polishing requirement for all Dental Assistants in the state of California. **Students will have the opportunity to intern in a local dental practice. This is for an additional 6 weeks after the 14 week program. Internship provides the students with a means of enhancing their skills and developing professional relationships with other dental healthcare providers.**

IMPORTANT SKILLS TO ENTER THE COURSE

- Willingness to work with others
- Regular school attendance
- Basic math and reading skills
