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How do I find out my child's teacher for the upcoming school year?

How do I receive emails from the district or school?

- Please establish and maintain your Parent Portal account as it will be the primary source for distribution of school and district information. Please make @syossetschools.org a "safe sender" on your email account

How do I locate my child's bus information?

- All registered students are eligible for busing. Bus information will be available in the Parent Portal **during the last week of summer**, and families will receive notification from the district once it's ready. **Please do not check the Portal before getting the email from the district as the bus information from last year will still be there.*
- Finding your child's bus on the Parent Portal.
 - Once you are signed into the Parent Portal, click on "More" and then "Transportation"
 - You will then be able to view your child's bus number, bus stop, and the time the bus is scheduled to arrive
- Please have your child at the bus stop five minutes before the indicated time

- **Kindergarten - Grade 2 Parents:**
 - A bus tag will be provided for you to affix to your child's backpack so the driver and school staff are aware that your child is in Kindergarten, Grade 1 or Grade 2.
 - BUS DISMISSAL

- Transportation has assigned all students a bus route
- Families or their designees should be at the appointed bus stop prior to when the child is scheduled to arrive
- *Bus drivers are explicitly directed to bring kindergarten through Grade 2 students back to school if no one is at the stop to take them off the bus.

What is the procedure if I want to “drop off” my child at school in the morning as a “walker”?

- Children and adult escort will form a line behind the indicated orange cones on either side of the main entrance between 8:50 a.m. - 9:00 a.m.
- Families and/or their designees are not permitted beyond the orange cones

When will my child be marked “late?”

- Any child arriving at school after 9:15 am will be marked “late.”
- All students arriving after 9:15 am must be escorted into the building by an adult. You will be asked to sign your child into school at the security booth.

How do I report my child’s absence?

- Village utilizes the PUP system which allows you a convenient, digital way to report an absence right from your phone or computer!
- *Click [here](#) for more details about accessing the PUP system
- If your child will be absent, you must report the absence in PUP by 8:30a.m.
- *Please do NOT email staff regarding absences
 - Emails to the main office staff OR emails to teachers are NOT a substitute for reporting the absence in PUP
- Attendance is checked carefully, the office will confirm an unreported absence with a phone call
- The PUP system allows you to make schedule changes in advance, there is no need to wait until the day of.
- *Excused absences are illness, medical appointments, and family loss

How are students dismissed at the end of the day?

- Village utilizes the PUP system which allows you a convenient, digital way to manage your child’s dismissal right from your phone or computer!
- For a safe dismissal, it is essential that we know your student’s regular daily dismissal plans **before** the first day of school.

- WALKER DISMISSAL
 - Families or their designees will meet children at the front doors at approximately 3:15pm

How do I change my child's regular dismissal arrangement for the day?

- Village utilizes the PUP system which allows you a convenient way to change your child's regular dismissal arrangement from your phone or computer!
- *Click [here](#) for more details about accessing the PUP system
- Daily dismissal changes may be made for any day (*even future dates*) by selecting the date and your desired dismissal plan.
- You have until **2:00 p.m.** on the day of the requested change to input your selection. *After 2:00 p.m., you will be locked out of the system for that day. This is to allow time for the staff to communicate the changes to the teachers, supervising staff and inform all children of the changes.

What is the procedure for picking up my child early from school?

- Please make every effort to schedule appointments outside of the school day. Early pick up causes disruption to instruction and dismissal procedures. If you must do so for emergency reasons, please note:
 - Early dismissal may be made for any day in PUP by selecting the date and your desired dismissal plan.
 - *Emails cannot be accepted.
 - All early pick ups must be completed by 2:45 pm. After this point, your child will be dismissed with their class at the end of the day.

What are the safety procedures for all during arrival and dismissal?

- For our children's safety, we request that you observe the following procedures regarding automobile traffic during arrival and dismissal times:
 - **The bus circle is closed to all traffic during the following times:**
 - 8:30–9:30 am during arrival
 - 2:45–3:45 pm during dismissal
 - **Please do not park in the staff parking lots or along the driveway** as there is limited space for school personnel.
 - **Please do NOT drop children off in the middle of Convent Road.** This is very dangerous.
 - **PLEASE RESPECT OUR NEIGHBORS**
 - *Please do NOT block our neighbors' driveways under any circumstances

What is the procedure for school supplies?

- The Village School Supply Drop Off is scheduled for:
 - Thursday, August 27 from 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
 - Friday, August 28 from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
- *No need to park! Please drive through the circle and a staff member will meet you at your vehicle
- *****Please label EACH INDIVIDUAL item:**
 - Child's Name
 - Teacher's Name
- ***If you purchased the supply kit through the PTA, please be sure to open the kit and label EACH INDIVIDUAL item with your child's name before dropping it off.
- ***We cannot accommodate school supplies being dropped off once school is in session. **If students are unable to carry everything in all at once, they may stagger this over a few days.**

What is the six-day schedule?

- All elementary schools in Syosset work on a six-day cycle. This means Special Area classes or early morning groups (such as extra help and music) will meet on designated days (Day 1, Day 2, Day 3, Day 4, Day 5, Day 6).

Will my child have snack time?

- Classroom teachers will discuss snack time with their students on the first day of school
- Parents are asked to carefully read the online statement on allergic reactions to certain foods
- Several filtered hydration stations are located throughout the building. If your child will want water during the day please send them to school each day with a personal water bottle labeled with their name

- Please send all food items to school at least 24–48 hours in advance of the celebration so that our school nurse has sufficient time to review and approve all food before it is shared with students.

- Any internet-enabled device that is brought to school must be silenced and kept in the classroom in the location designated by the teacher.
