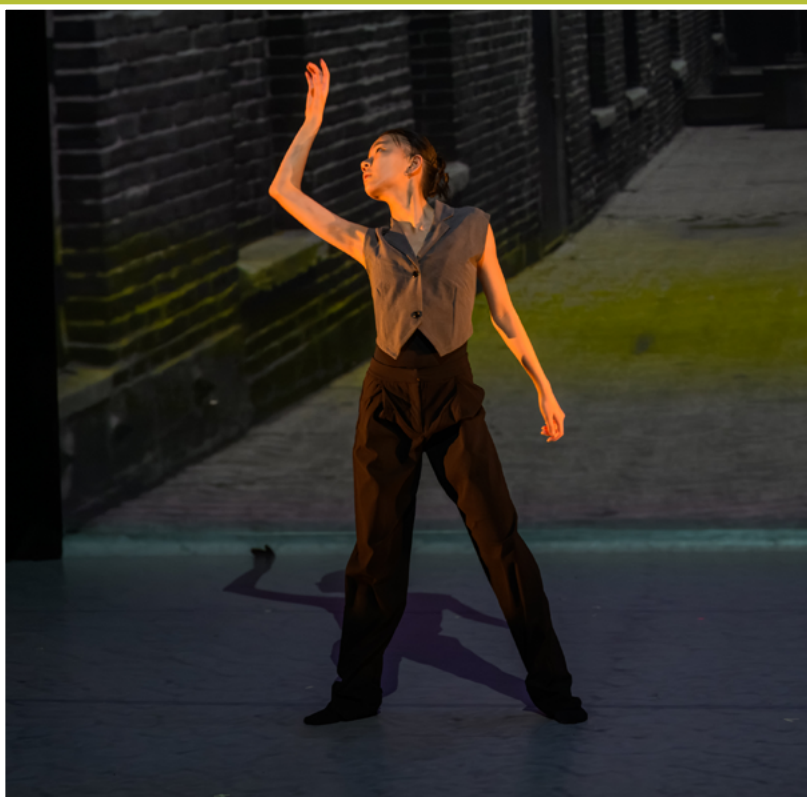

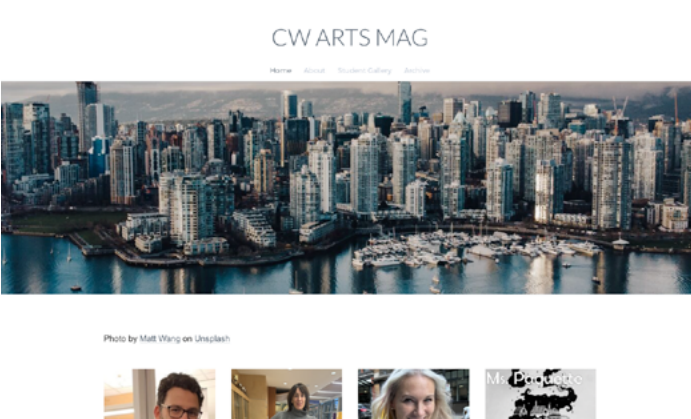


Admissions Ambassadors

Duration	All Year
Eligibility	Grade 8-12

The Admissions Ambassador Program is a leadership opportunity for students in grades 11 to 12 and a service opportunity for students in grades 8 to 12 who are dedicated to serving and representing Collingwood School throughout the year. Admissions Ambassadors are students who model the school’s values and embody the school’s vision and mission. They are students in good standing, engaged in their education, involved in the school community, and respected by their peers and teachers.

Participation in this program is through an application process, an interview, and extensive training. Students interested in this program have an opportunity to join in a Leadership position (for Gr.s 11-12) or a Service position (for Gr. 8-12). All members of the Admissions Ambassadors program are trained to lead campus tours, to serve as greeters and campus hosts at events, including speaking on a panel, and represent the School at community events. The application and selection of Admissions Ambassadors occurs annually.

Join us to collaborate, explore careers in fashion and design, and bring your ideas to life. No prior experience needed, just creativity and curiosity!

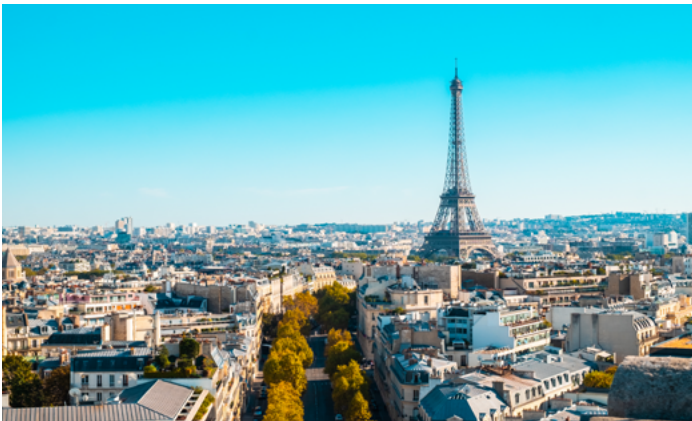


Film & Media Club

Each term, 24 students (two from each grade in every House) take part in a 6-session rotation of weekly 45–60 minute sessions. The program is led by Head Students with coaching support from Ms. Weiss. Students learn to recognize their strengths, step outside their comfort zones, and practice taking initiative within a team. This is the first stage in Collingwood’s leadership pathway, preparing students to transition from personal leadership in Grades 8–9 to leading for others in Grades 10–12.

Public Speaking Club: Kairos



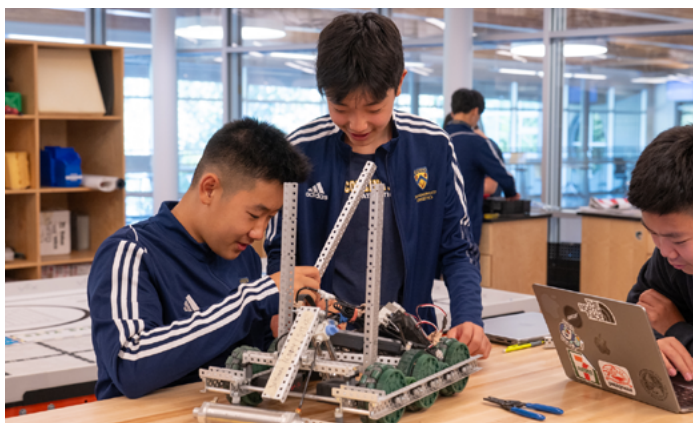
