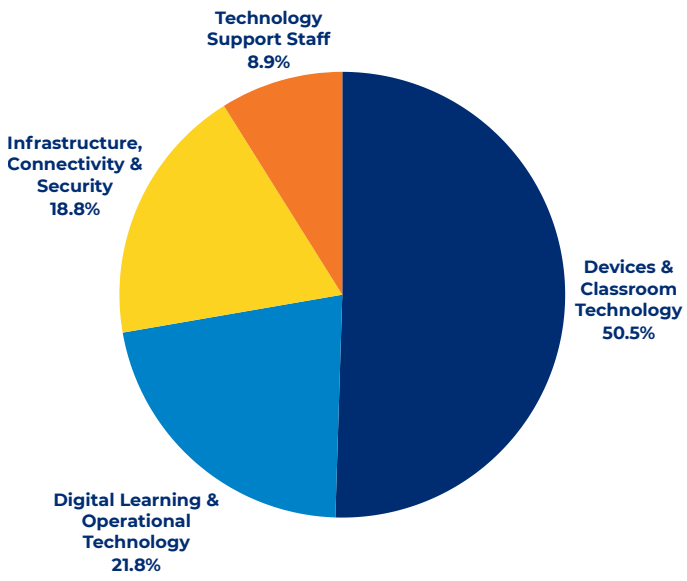

Since 2015, Robbinsdale Area Schools has strategically utilized capital projects technology levy funds to modernize our learning environments. By focusing on **four key areas**, we ensure our students and educators are equipped to excel in an evolving digital landscape.

10-YEAR LEVY SPENDING BY AREA (2015-2025)



- **Devices & Classroom Technology** – Student and staff devices, classroom displays, audio systems, and printers
- **Digital Learning & Technology** – Learning platforms, digital tools, software, and subscriptions
- **Infrastructure & Security** – Network, Wi-Fi, internet, cybersecurity, and supporting technology
- **Technology Support** – Staff support, device repairs, systems support, and technology assistance
