He stated: Ma'am, Sir, at Special Board meetings the policy only allows that citizens discuss items that are on the agenda and she is talking about things that are clearly not on the agenda so I recommend that we ask her to stop and that we ask her to come at a regular meeting when she can talk or file a proper grievance. OPEN SESSION

1. Discuss and consider action regarding issuance of decision to adopt, reject, or change the Independent Hearing Examiners recommendation in the matter of South San Antonio I.S.D. v. Eric Negron, TEA Docket No. 149-LH-05-2026 (Section 21.259 of the Texas Education Code) and take action to finalize termination of Eric Negron's continuing contract.
Mrs. Sanchez made a motion: I move that the Board of Managers having considered the recommendation of the independent hearing examiner and including all findings of fact, conclusions of law, and discussion contained therein and having reviewed the record of the hearing in the matter of South San ISD vs Eric Negron TEA Docket No. 149-LH-05-2026 adopt the recommendation in its entirety, specifically the Board adopts the independent hearing examiners findings of fact for charge #1 numbered 1-31, the findings of fact for charge #2 numbered 1-8, the discussion and the conclusions of law numbered 1-11, the Board further finds that charge #1 respondents unjustified use of force and charge #2 respondents failure to comply with Board policies and to meet the districts standards of professional conduct each independently establishes good cause for termination and the Board adopts each as a separate and sufficient basis for its decision, the Board further finds that the district has good cause to terminate respondents continuing employment contract that respondent is not immune from this proceeding under Texas Education Code section 22.0512 and that the proposed termination is approved, I therefore move that the Board finalize the termination of Mr. Negron's

continuing employment contract with the district effective immediately and direct the Board President to provide respondent written notice of this decision in accordance with law, Mr. Guerra seconded. Mr. Tijerina posed: All in favor say I, all said I, Mr. Tijerina stated that the motion carries. He further stated: The Board adopts the recommendation of the hearing examiner and approves the termination of Mr. Negron's continuing contract effective immediately. The Board President is directed to provide written notice of the decision to the respondent in accordance with the law. Is there any further business to come before the Board on this matter? There being none, this matter is concluded. Mr. Resendez, Legal Counsel, stated for clarification for the court reporter that there were 6 votes all in favor.
