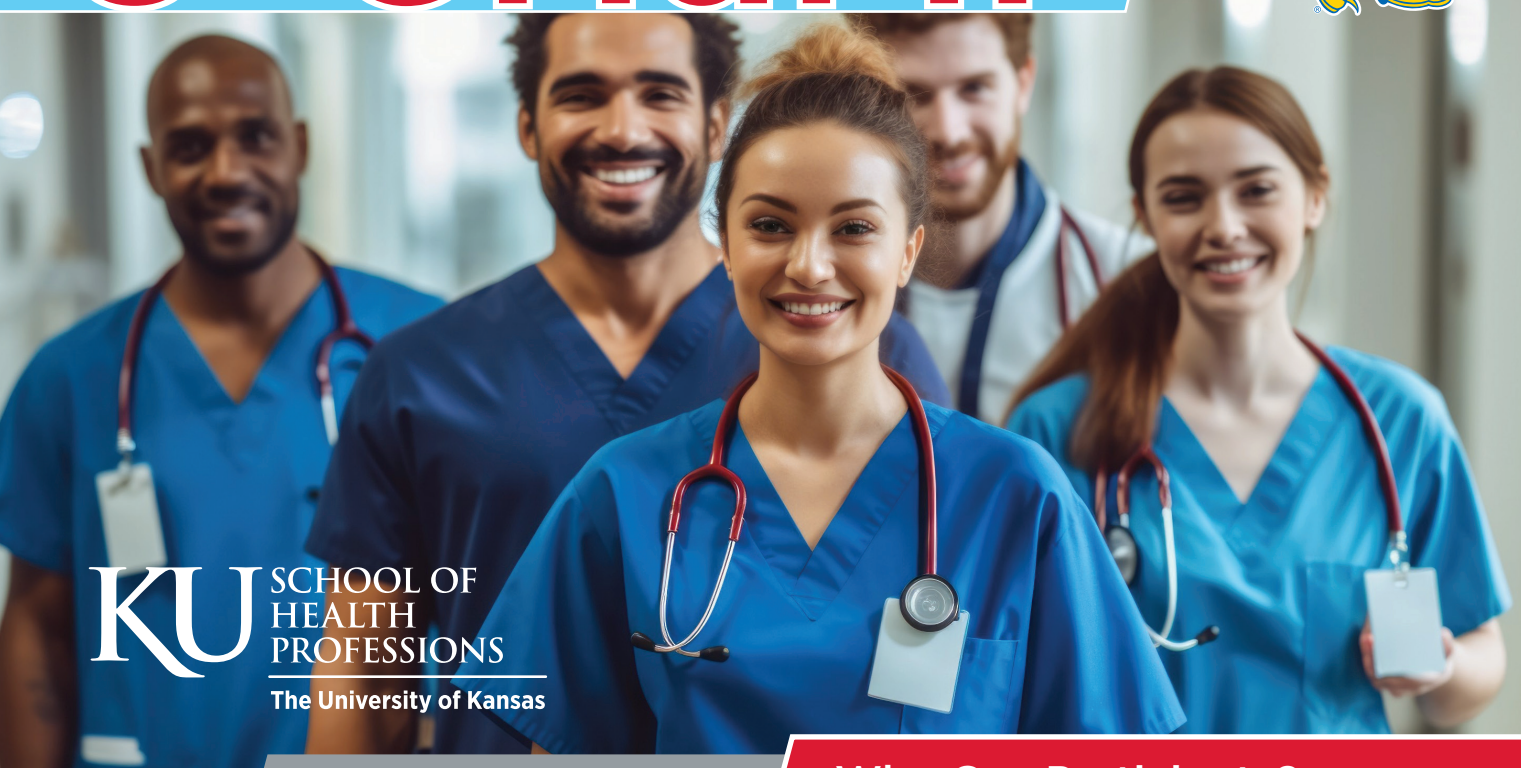

Who Can Participate?

To be eligible, you'll need to meet both of these requirements:

- 1 Currently enrolled as a high school junior or senior, or enrolled at a community college or four-year university, or is an adult non-traditional learner (including military veterans).
- 2 Be a first-generation college student – OR – attend a high school with a high number of free and reduced lunch-eligible students – OR – meet specific income guidelines.

The U-CHaMP program provides students from underserved backgrounds an opportunity to learn about and enroll in an academic program in the School of Health Professions at KU Medical Center.

Students in U-CHaMP gain leadership skills, receive unique mentoring and advising opportunities, and enjoy immersive clinical experiences in rural and underserved communities. Those accepted are eligible for a substantial scholarship to support their study in a health professions degree program at the University of Kansas.

- Gain invaluable experience working with underserved populations and learning about health disparities.

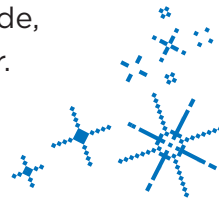


Health Care Careers = In Demand!
