The student population is drawn from suburban and rural areas of south San Jose, Morgan Hill, Coyote Valley and San Martin.

Grading

Grading is awarded on a per-semester basis at the end of December and June.

GPA

GPA is computed each semester and cumulatively at the end of grades 9, 10, 11, and 12. Our students are ranked on Weighted Total GPA (9-12).

GPA is based on the following schedule:
A = 4 (90-100), B = 3 (80-89), C = 2 (70-79),
D = 1 (60-69), F = 0 (<60)

AP Classes and Dual Enrollment classes offer a GPA boost upon successful completion (grade of C or better). In addition, most Dual Enrollment offer an extra 5 credits per semester.
