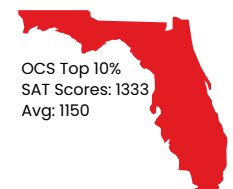
In 2025-2026 OCS students set an all-time high on AP exams. **8 of our 12 AP courses had a 100% pass rate.** 116 HS students, grades 10-12, took 198 exams with 90% of students earning a passing score of 3 or higher, equating to **661 college hours, or nearly \$903,367 in saved private school tuition or \$140,601 public school tuition.**
