If you are picking up a first grader and also have an older sibling, the older sibling will be dismissed with their class at their designated dismissal location. If the older sibling has permission to be dismissed independently, they may meet you at the front entrance. If you would like to use this option, please be sure to update your child's dismissal permissions in PowerSchool. Otherwise, the older sibling will remain with their teacher at the designated dismissal location until you arrive to pick them up.

A quick note from Officer Mario: **Please do not pull into the teachers' parking lot after 7:30 a.m.** Thank you for helping us keep our arrival procedures safe and running smoothly for everyone.
