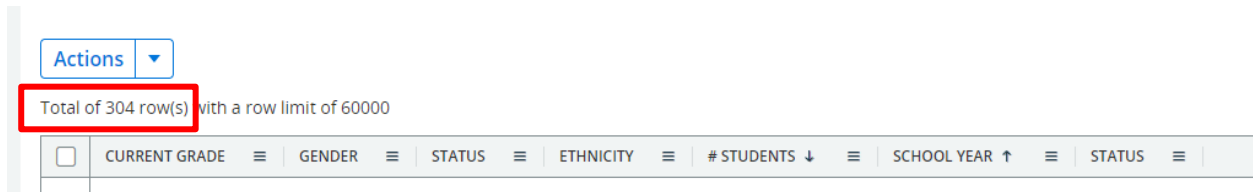


STATS- Student Counts

When drilling into metrics, the resulting table will give a count of the rows of data.

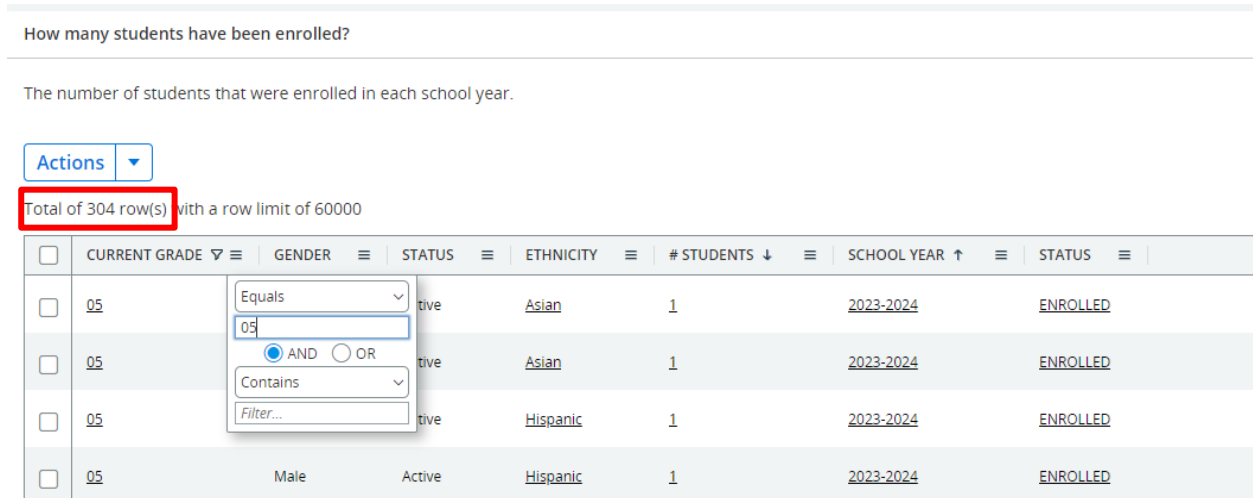

There are a few ways to generate counts of filtered tables.

Applying student group filters to metric cards in the Enrollment and Program dashboards

After filtering a table, the students can be added to a Student Group filter and then the dashboards can be filtered by that Student Group. Student Groups can be deleted if they are only being used to generate counts.

Metric cards with counts:

Enrollment -> Enrollment Overview -> Enrollment Information

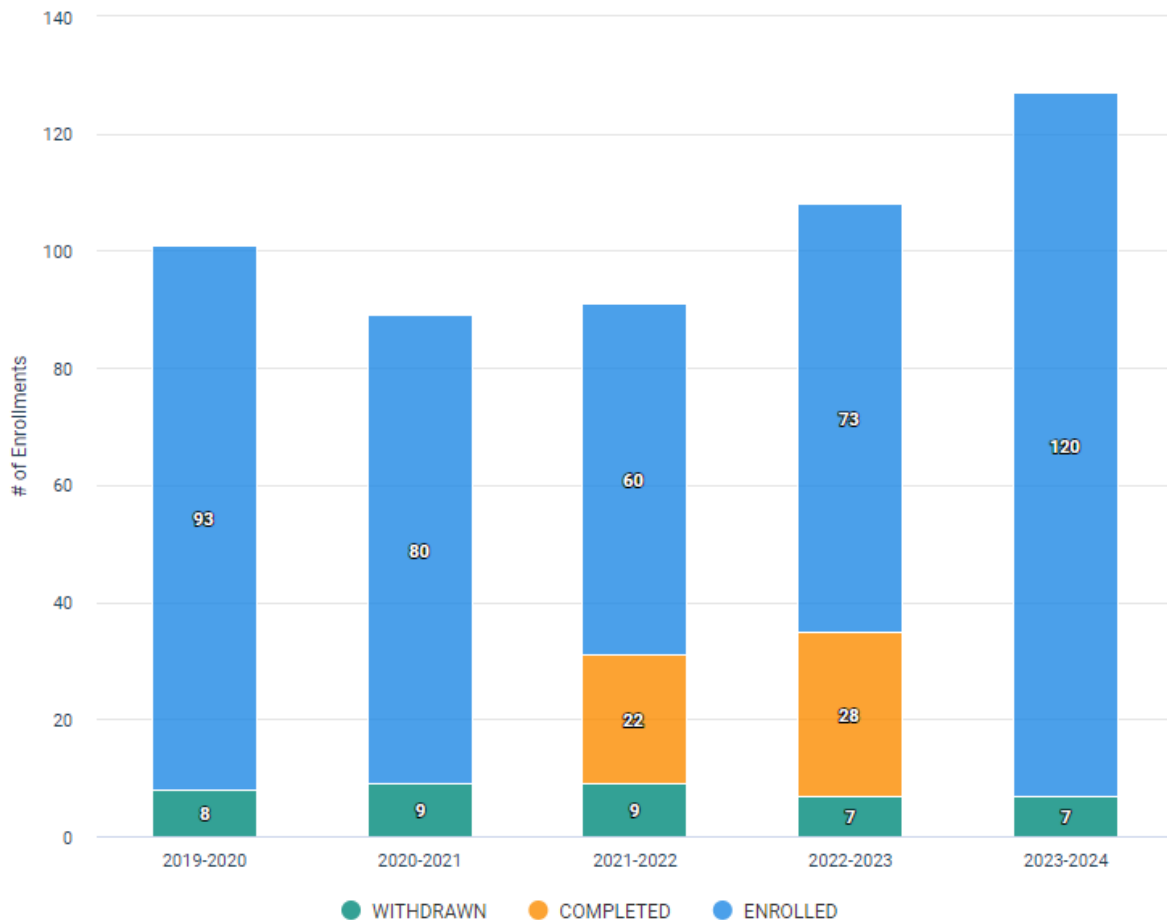
This metric card returns data for **active** students, and will provide a total count of students in the group (top, "Total") as well as counts for student subgroups. In this case, the dashboard has been filtered for students identified as SPED. Currently there are 120 students with IEPs enrolled.

Enrollment -> Enrollment Overview -> How many students have been enrolled?

How many students have been enrolled?

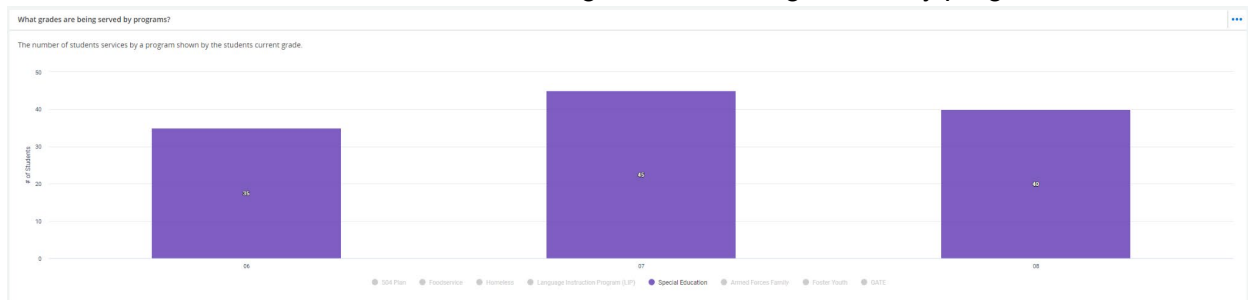


The number of students that were enrolled in each school year.



This metric card returns data for **all students who have been enrolled**, regardless of whether they are active or not. In this case, the dashboards are still filtered for students with IEPs, and we can see that 120 are enrolled (matching the current enrollment from the previous metric card), and that 7 students with IEPs have withdrawn at some point during the year.

Enrollment -> Enrollment Overview -> What grades are being served by programs?



This metric card returns data for **active** students, and broken up by grade level. Programs on the x axis can be clicked off, leaving just data for a specific program. In this case, only Special Education is active on the card, and the sum of the student counts for each grade level equals 120.
