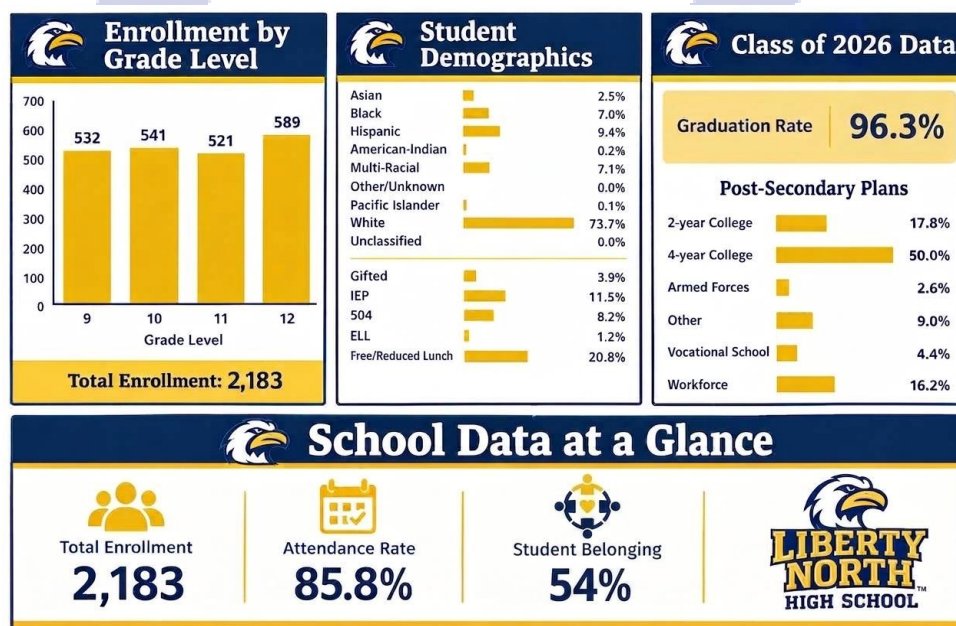

LPS offers three diploma types – Silver, Gold, and Platinum – and requires all students to earn at least one Market Value Asset (MVA) prior to graduation.

- Silver diploma earners attain the state minimum of 24 credits and earn 1 MVA.
- Gold diploma earners attain the LPS standard of 25.5 credits and earn 2 MVA.
- Platinum diploma earners attain the maximum of 28 credits and earn 2 MVAs.

Transcripts reflect both an unweighted GPA based on a 4.0 scale and a weighted GPA in which an additional 1.0 point is added to reflect the grades students earn in Advanced Placement and Dual Credit classes: A=5.0, B=4.0, C=3.0, D=2.0, F=0.0
