Tax Rate Hearing/Regular Session

Board President Levi Mallory called the Tax Rate Hearing to order at 6:55 pm. Board members present were Emily Davies, Blake Peters, Jamie Clevenger, Levi Mallory, Cassie Kleeman, Sharon Wright, and Jake Haley. Also present were Superintendent Daniel Street, District Bookkeeper Brooke Cox, High School Principal James Oyler, Elementary Principal Tyna Morrison, Athletic Director and Secondary Educator Angie Stone, and Elementary educators Erika Swindler and Traci Heussner.

Board President Levi Mallory called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Board members present were Emily Davies, Blake Peters, Jamie Clevenger, Levi Mallory, Cassie Kleeman, Sharon Wright, and Jake Haley. Also present were Superintendent Daniel Street, District Bookkeeper Brooke Cox, High School Principal James Oyler, Elementary Principal Tyna Morrison, Athletic Director and Secondary Educator Angie Stone, and Elementary educators Erika Swindler and Traci Heussner.

Jamie Clevenger made a motion to approve the agenda. Cassie Kleeman seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

Emily Davies made a motion to approve the consent agenda, including previous Board Meeting minutes, financial statements and payment of bills, and the current substitute list. Cassie Kleeman seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

The Board reviewed Administrative reports, followed by the Superintendent's report.

After the scheduled tax rate hearing of the School District, board member Jamie Clevenger made the motion and board member Sharon Wright seconded the motion to approve the following resolution setting the school district's tax rate ceiling for the 2026-27 tax year. It is resolved that the School District in consideration of the educational opportunities and expenses for the students, the maintenance and care of facilities, and operational needs of the school district will set the operating tax rate ceiling at \$3.8841, the approved State Auditors ceiling if no voluntary reductions were taken in prior even numbered years (Informational Page, Line F).

Emily Davies made a motion to set the 2026-27 Tax Rate at \$3.8841 (of which \$0.32 of will go to Fund 40). Jamie Clevenger seconded the motion, and all members present voted yes.

Emily Davies made a motion to approve the IDEA Compliance Plan as presented. Jamie Clevenger seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

Emily Davies made a motion to approve the 2026-27 transportation routes as presented. Sharon Wright seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

Emily Davies made a motion to approve the Wellness Center Operation Guidelines as presented. Jamie Clevenger seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

Emily Davies made a motion to update Elementary, Secondary, and Employee Handbooks as presented with revisions. Jamie Clevenger seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

Jake Haley made a motion to approve district payment of employee cafeteria meals for the 2026-27 school year. Emily Davies seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.

CSIP updates were discussed.

Policy review covered Section MCE 3000 – 3320.

Jamie Clevenger seconded the motion and all members present voted yes.
