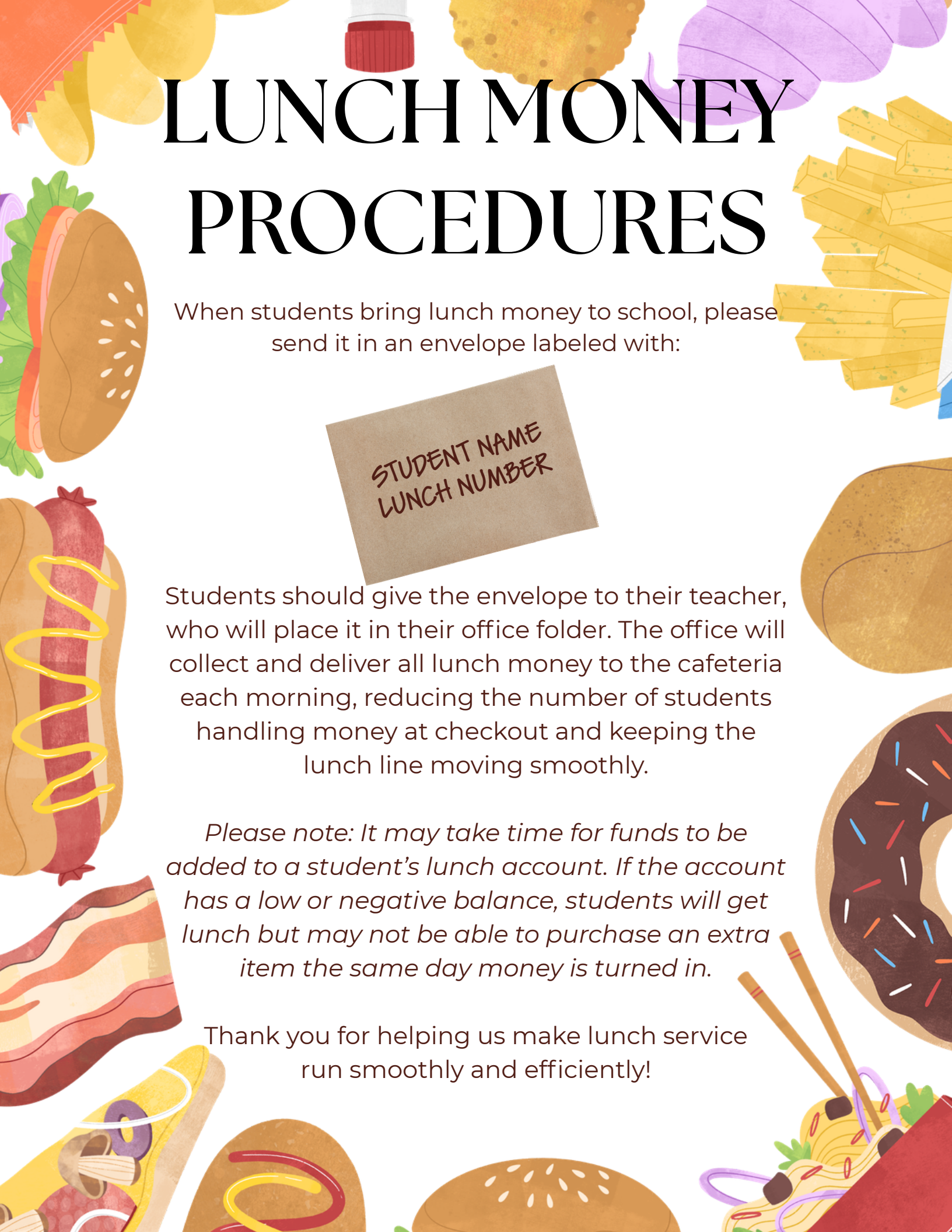
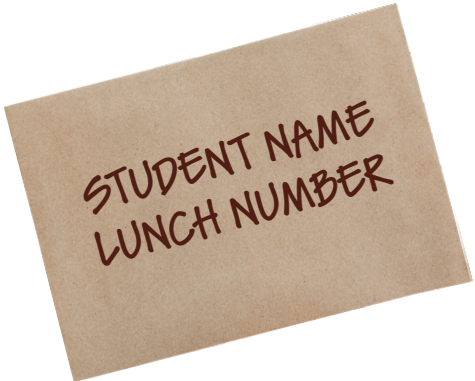

LUNCH MONEY PROCEDURES

When students bring lunch money to school, please
send it in an envelope labeled with:

Students should give the envelope to their teacher,
