When concerns arise, staff will work with the student and family to clarify expectations and support improvement. Repeated unsafe, disrespectful, or significantly disruptive behavior may result in a review of the student’s continued participation in the program.

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Musical Instrument Use Agreement

2026-2027

As a participant in the PUSD Mariachi Performing Arts Program, the student named below may be issued a musical instrument, accessories, uniform, shoes, or other program equipment. All issued items remain the property of PUSD and may be used only for participation in the Mariachi Performing Arts Program.

Care and Use of Musical Instruments

Musical instruments are fragile and must be handled carefully. Students agree to follow these guidelines:

- Store the instrument in its case when it is not being used.
- Secure all handles, hinges, latches, and zippers before carrying the instrument.
- Do not place objects on top of the instrument or inside its case unless the case is designed to hold them.
- Do not leave the instrument in a vehicle, direct sunlight, or extremely hot, cold, or humid conditions.
- Do not leave the instrument unattended.
- Use a clean, soft, untreated cloth to remove fingerprints, dust, and residue before storing the instrument.
- Do not attempt to repair the instrument at home.
- Report damage or problems with the instrument to the instructor or program team immediately.

Loss, Theft, or Damage

The student and parent or guardian agree to exercise reasonable care while program equipment is checked out to the student. If an issued item is lost, stolen, vandalized, or damaged, the parent or guardian must:

- Notify the program team as soon as possible, but no later than 24 hours after discovering the incident.
- File a police report when theft or vandalism has occurred and provide a copy to the District.
- Provide any additional documentation reasonably requested by the District.

When loss or damage results from misuse, negligence, or failure to follow the care requirements, the family may be financially responsible for repair or replacement, consistent with District policy and applicable law.

Return of Equipment

PUSD may require the return of any program-issued equipment when:

- The student withdraws or is no longer enrolled in the program.
- The equipment requires inspection, maintenance, or repair.
- The student is not following the terms of this agreement or applicable District policies.
- The equipment is otherwise needed or requested by the District.



All issued items must be returned in their current condition, allowing for reasonable wear from proper use.
