Purpose of This Meeting:

- Review the revised timeline, work plan, and subcommittee charter.
- Establish a shared understanding of key questions the data should help answer.
- Review and provide feedback on the districtwide data dashboard and identify any additional data needs.
- Develop a common understanding of the evaluation framework and establish decision-making principles used to assess each region.
- Prepare for upcoming regional analyses by identifying trends, questions, and additional information needed.

Communication:

On September 22, 2026, the Superintendent Enrollment Planning Advisory Committee (SEPAC) gathered for its sixth meeting. The session focused on establishing transparent evaluation structures, refining data dashboards, and defining core principles to guide long-term district planning.

During the meeting, committee members engaged in targeted sub-committee breakout sessions:

- **School Consolidation and Closure:** Reviewed regional data maps across five district regions (Northeast, Northwest, Southeast, Southwest, and West Central) and the Middle Schools, updated data dashboard metrics, shared follow-up from August meeting feedback, and drafted key decision-making principles to guide the subcommittee. The subcommittee confirmed a revised work plan targeting recommendations for school closure and consolidation for cabinet and board consideration in December 2027.
- **Marketing and Communication:** Focused on measuring communication effectiveness, establishing metrics for a new marketing and communication dashboard, and prioritizing leading measures to strengthen community engagement.
- **School Programming:** Reviewed expectations regarding upcoming sub-committee work for the next few meetings. The sub-committee was presented with an example model of a successful specialized program in the East Valley.

The committee remains committed to open and transparent communication. Key guiding principles and meeting schedules will be published on the district website.
