Grade 10	Must pass both your English and Math class, along a minimum of 1 credit earned in both Science and Social Studies, along with a total of 11 credits to promote to 11th.
Grade 11	Must have acquired 17 units of credit including 3 credits each in English & Math, and 2 credits each in Science and Social Studies to promote to 12th.
Grade 12	To earn a high school diploma, the student must have met all necessary course and state testing requirements on their selected diploma pathway.
